

Green Teams National Programme Accelerating sustainability in the workplace

Online programme summary







Programme background

The Green Teams National Programme helps members of green teams and environmental champions in organisations to gain basic **technical knowledge** on resource efficiency, develop the skills they need to **promote sustainable action** to their colleagues in the workplace and gain **formal recognition** in the process in the form of a Certificate of Recognition. The programme was developed under the **EPA's Green** Enterprise scheme.

Objectives

The main programme objectives are:

- To provide recognition for green team members and environmental champions.
- To provide green team members / champions with an understanding of the requirements of the role.
- To promote an understanding of the key concepts involved in environmental engagement / awareness and hence to help champions perform their role in an informed manner.
- To provide champions with the means to implement simple and more advanced measures to reduce their organisation's environmental impacts.
- To equip participants with the necessary skills to lead change in their work areas.

Who is the programme for?

The Green Teams National Programme is designed principally staff who are nominated 'environmental champions' Green members, or equivalent, or other members of nontechnical staff who may have a responsibility for environmental aspects of their organisation. It is expected that individual participants in the course are not technically qualified in the resource efficiency themes to be covered.

Delivery

The online programme is presented through a range of modules (shown below) with learning materials and activities suggested for self-study.

The modules are delivered through 3 - 4 **online sessions** over a period of 4 - 6 weeks (the time period may be adapted to suit the needs of the participating organisation). Each online session (on each day) consists of a live presentation of approx. 2.5 hrs.

Activities, assignments and resources

The online training is supplemented by a range of activities and assignments for participants to complete. Reference material is provided along with links to required or additional readings and multimedia resources. Access to all material is made available through the Programme 'Moodle' website.

Online Programme Modules

Getting Staff Buy-in

Team Project

Participants will carry out a workplace project over a period of about 3 months, while working in teams of at least two people. The time required for this would depend on the project. In conjunction with the online tuition, this helps build staff environmental training which is a key feature of successful CSR activities.





All participants in the Programme will have secure access to the MOODLE Virtual Learning Environment, on which all learning material will be made available. MOODLE offers a range of additional functionality, including content management, email, discussion, calendar and chat room.



Assessment

Participants are assessed by means of short answer and multiple choice **tests** at the end of each training session, along with the completion of a workplace **team project**.

Certificate of Recognition

Participants in the Green Teams National Programme are provided with a Certificate of Recognition.
